2. A typical tiny house is defined as a home with square footage between 9 – 37 square meters



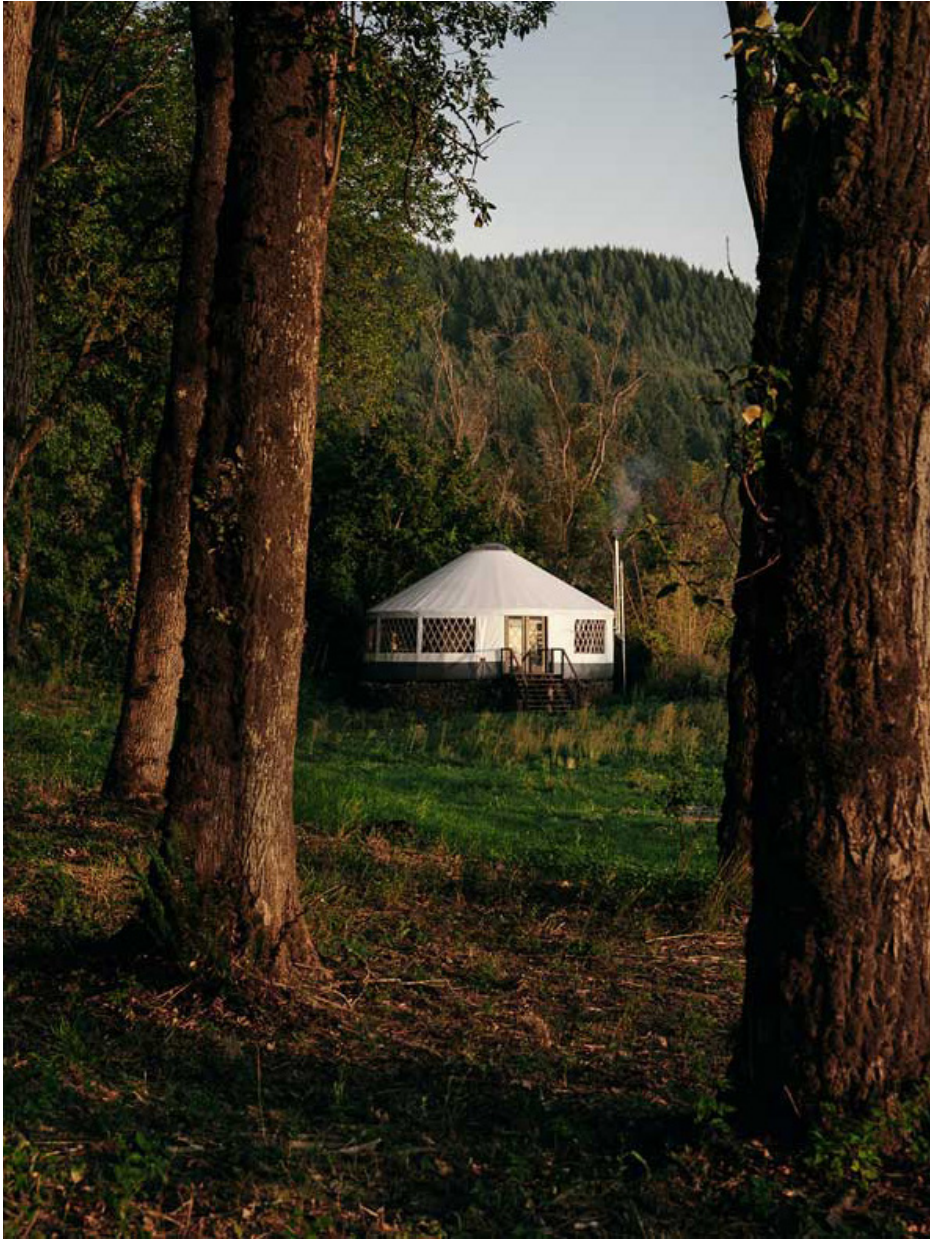












Off Grid

ˌɒf.ðə'ɡrɪd *adjective, adverb*

1. Not connected to the main electricity grid (= system of connected wires and power stations)
2. Not connected to any of the main utilities (= electricity, water, etc.) and having your own power and water supply

On Grid

/ɒn/ + /grɪd/ *adjective, adverb*

1. Connected to the main electricity grid (= system of connected wires and power stations)
2. Connected to all of the main utilities (= electricity, water, etc.)

Passiefwoning

// *noun*

1. Lage-energiewoning

2. Een woning met een permanent goed binnenklimaat, zonder traditioneel verwarmings- of koelsysteem. En dat zowel in de winter als in de zomer. Vandaar ook de naam. We spreken van een passiefhuis als er niet meer dan 15 kWh/m² per jaar nodig is voor de verwarming van de ruimtes tot 20° C.

Self-Sufficient

/ˌselfsəˈfɪʃnt/ *adjective*

1. Can meet your needs like food, shelter, water, and energy without over-reliance on outside resources
2. State of being in which a person or an organization needs little or no help from, or interaction with, others
3. Opposite to consumer-driven society

Moveable

/ˈmuːvəbl/ *adjective, noun*

1. Capable of being moved
2. Property or possessions not including land or buildings

Fixed

/fɪkst/

adjective

1. Arranged or decided already and not able to be changed
2. Fastened securely in position

Modular

/ˈmɒdʒ.ə.lər/ adjective

1. Employing or involving a module or modules as the basis of design or construction
2. Consisting of separate parts that, when combined, form a complete whole
3. Made from a set of separate parts that can be joined together to form a larger object

Sashimono

/ˈsa.sji.moonoo/ ***noun***

1. Technique for assembling furniture and other wooden items without nails, using both simple and highly complex wood joints
2. Japanese tradition of making furniture without the use of nails or screws

Vernacular

/və'næk.jə.lər/ *noun*

1. A local style in which ordinary houses are built
2. A term used to categorize architectural design which uses locally available resources and traditions to address local building and design needs
3. Tends to evolve over time to reflect the environmental, cultural and historical context in which it exists

Geotourism

/ˈdʒiːəʊ,ɡɪˈəʊ/ + /ˈtʊərɪz(ə)m/ noun

1. Tourism that sustains or enhances the geographical character of a place: its environment, culture, aesthetics, heritage, and the well-being of its residents
2. Principles, methods, and tools to implement sustainable tourism programs
